Newnham Priory opened in 1166. The monks moved to Newnham after a murder scandal in their old home!


### **FACT**

You can find the old Priory Fishponds in a bumpy field by the




What would the monks make of today's noisy cars and bustling visitors? What do you think the medieval monks and modern families have in common?
